It provides an open-access platform for publishing the research results of elementary, middle, and high school students, as well as individuals involved in their education. The journal offers Japanese and English translations at no cost to the authors for readers in Japan and overseas.

Submission Guidelines and Procedures

Outline

- 1. There is no charge for publication in this journal.
- 2. Copyright of articles published in this journal remains with the authors.
- 3. The editorial board of this journal assumes no responsibility for the content of articles.
- 4. Manuscripts should be submitted online at "scistars-j@ginsight-jpn.com".
- 5. The types of articles accepted include full papers, notes, reports, and reviews. Other forms of articles, such as articles approved by the editorial board, may also be published.

Full Papers

- To publish research that can be replicated later, the results must be based on at least three repetitions, not just a single experiment. However, this does not apply to observations over time or in images. Additionally, statistical analysis is recommended when discussing significant differences in results.
- 2. Conclusions must be derived from multiple different methodologies.
- 3. Experimental methods must be described in a manner that allows for subsequent verification.
- 4. Novelty is not considered highly important, and so-called "copying" is welcome. Research that builds upon prior studies by first verifying the reproducibility of their results and then developing them further is acceptable.
- 5. There is no page limit.

Notes

1. Papers that meet the requirements for full papers but are only about three pages long (short reports) will be published as notes.

Preliminary Reports

1. A research paper or conference presentation that is considered significant despite its incompleteness may be accepted as a preliminary report. In such cases, the paper may be submitted as a full paper at a later date when the data is supplemented.

Review Articles

1. Papers prepared based on themes requested by the editorial committee, as well as submitted papers that align with the journal's publication objectives and are approved by the editorial committee, may be published as review articles. For example, a review paper on "The history and recent research on ant studies by children."

Editorial

1. The editorial board will periodically publish paper introductions, paper reviews, comments, and other content.
